

Straight Kill Films Inc. Privacy Policy

Straightkillfilms.com (the "Website") is an online website providing you with the information regarding the activities of Straight Kill Films, Inc. ("SKF"), including, but not limited to, the upcoming "Straight Kill" movie, the Straight Kill Auditions, and information about the SKF team.

SKF takes the privacy of Personal Information (as defined below) held by us seriously, and the Straight Kill Films Inc. Privacy Policy (the "Privacy Policy") is designed to help you understand how we collect and use the Personal Information that you provide on the Website and how that information may be subsequently used.

"Personal Information" means any information about an identifiable individual including, but not limited to, name, home address, email address, telephone number, social media handles and uploaded content.

Consent

By visiting the Website, you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your Personal Information as described in this Privacy Policy. You may withdraw your consent to the use of your Personal Information by contacting the Privacy Officer as provided below. However, if you withdraw your consent, you may not be able to interact with the Website. If do not accept this policy, you must not use the Website.

Collection of Personal Information

When you visit the Website, the only Personal Information we collect is information you provide to us voluntarily by sending it to us electronically using the links or forms contained on the Website including, but not limited to, completing a submission form, providing us feedback and sending us emails. We may also collect website use information as you interact with the Website.

When you enter the Website, we collect certain information from your browser using cookies. Cookies are small files that are stored on your computer that help us to optimize your experience on the Website. We also use web beacons which are electronic images used to track the movement of a visitor on the Website. Most browser software will allow you to disable and delete cookies. If you choose to do so, this may interfere with your ability to personalize and be recognized by the Website and slow down the performance of your Website experience.

Use of Your Personal Information

We use your Personal Information for the following purposes:

1. to provide you with access to the Website;
2. to customize your experience;
3. to deliver services offered through the Website;
4. develop and maintain our relationship with you and communicate with you; and
5. to record your interactions with the Website for the purposes of improving and planning the service.

Disclosure of Personal Information

Unless agreed to otherwise, SKF will not disclose your Personal Information to any other persons without your prior consent, other than as provided for herein.

SKF may transfer (or otherwise make available) your Personal Information to our affiliates and other third parties who provide services on our behalf. For example, we may use service providers to host our Website, operate certain of its features, serve advertisements on our Website, send e-mail, SMS text messages or other communications, run our contests and promotions, conduct customer research, manage and analyze data and our advertising effectiveness.

SKF may provide any of your Personal Information to its external suppliers, but only to fulfill the purposes as described in this Privacy Policy. SKF may provide third parties with certain aggregated, anonymous data about your use of the Website. It will not include information that could personally identify you. We reserve the right to access and to disclose personal information to comply with applicable laws and lawful government requests, requests by regulatory bodies, to operate the Website and/or to protect SKF and its affiliates.

We may transfer any information we have about you as an asset in connection with a merger or sale (including transfers made as part of insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings) involving all or part of SKF or any affiliate thereof or as part of a corporate reorganization or stock sale or other change in corporate control.

Security

We have adopted reasonable security measures in an effort to protect Personal Information from loss, misuse or alteration while it is under our control. We use reasonable technical, contractual, administrative and physical measures to protect against unauthorized access. Unfortunately, no collection or transmission of information over the Internet or other publicly accessible communications networks is absolutely secure. We caution you to be aware of this fact before you send us an email message through the Website.

The Website contains links to other websites that operate independently of SKF and are not under our control. We provide links to other websites solely for your convenience and information.
